## Solution 1 - The Way of Cain

The "Way of Cain" is *rejection, jealousy, and envy*.

1. Write the offense you are carrying. Do not be too specific - just write enough that you have record of it in your hand.
2. Turn the situation over to the Lord. Give it to Him totally and immediately.
3. Make a decision to forgive
4. Speak the forgiveness out of your mouth.
5. Begin to act as though the offense never happened.
6. Sow a seed of love into the very life against whom you carried the offense. Sow an offering of love.

## Solution 2 - The Error of Balaam

The "Error of Balaam" is *doing something for personal profit and not sacrificial service*.

1. Turn your desire for profit and advancement over to God.
2. Make a decision that you will trust God and not man to bring promotion.
3. Begin to make advances to walk in humility and faith toward God and others.
4. Give an offering of time and money to others without expecting anything in return.

## Solution 3 - The Rebellion of Korah

The "Rebellion of of Korah" is *having a spirit of rebellion and judgement with no heart to submit to anyone, not even God*.

1. Read Romans 2:1  
*"Therefore you are inexcusable, O man, whoever you are who judge, for in whatever you judge another you condemn yourself, for you who judge practice the same things."*
2. Repent. Ask God to forgive you.
3. Go to those you have talked to and listened to, share with them about the rebellion of Korah, and ask for their forgiveness. Caution them about a judgemental spirit.
4. If the pastor knows what has been going on, go to Him and ask forgiveness.
5. Begin to spend time you used talking about people and listening to gossip helping those in the church who need help. Find some widows and orphans and do the work of the ministry.
6. Become an armorbearer for someone in the ministry. Serve him or her as though you were serving the Lord personally.
