A. HELPS

The gift of helps is the distinctive ability to work with and support other Christian ministry efforts by meeting the practical needs of others.

The gift of leadership is the ability to influence others according to a purpose, mission or plan.

The gift of hospitality is the ability to make people feel "at home", welcome, cared for, and part of the group.

The gift of teaching is the ability to employ a logical systematic approach to biblical study in preparation for clearly communicating practical truth to the body of Christ.

M. PASTOR/ SHEPHERD

N. APOSTLESHIP

O. PROPHECY

P. EVANGELISM.
